Central PA World Hunger Association: The Central PA World Hunger Assoc. conducts a meat canning project each year in Lewistown, Pa. This is the 49th year of the canning project and we plan to process 30,000 lbs. of chicken. We use MCC'S portable meat canner and 90% of the meat gets distributed thru MCC to needs around the world. Ten percent of the meat stays in the local area to be used in food pantry's, soup kitchens and various needs. All of our people are volunteers and all monies go to complete the project. The average cost to hold the event the last six years was \$69,634, with meat being the main expense. We expect our needs to be higher this year with the price of meat being high. We appreciate any gift we receive and may God bless you as you give.
